# Naidu woos Koreans to invest in AP solar sector

**Amaravati:** Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu requested OCI CEO and president WooHyun Lee to invest in the solar sector in Andhra Pradesh during former's visit to South Korea on Wednesday.

The OCI company is a Seoul-based trading company, engaged in import, export, supply of chemical products and raw materials apart from solar power.

While stating that he had participated in the last year's Partnership Summit in Vizag and following the progress of Andhra

Pradesh, Lee said he was impressed with the non-conventional renewable energy and solar energy policy of AP.

## Meet with LG officials

President of LG Electronics Soon Kwon expressed his willingness to explore opportunities in AP in battery storage and electronics, reacting to the proposal of Naidu for a collaboration in manufacturing of energy storage systems and display systems like LED and OLED screens.

Kwon said they have not set up a complete manufacturing unit outside Korea, and enquired

about the competitive advantage of Andhra Pradesh over other states. Reacting to that, Naidu said AP ranked number 1 in the Ease of Doing Business. "Even Foxconn left Tamil Nadu and came to AP, and now employs 13,000 people in AP", the Chief Minister said.

Kwon said that it is unusual to see a government leader speak with such technological awareness, and he will consider exploring opportunities in AP. The delegation led by Chandrababu Naidu spent their third and last day of the foreign visit in Seoul in South Korea on Wednesday.
